PART 4: MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

A. MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Unless otherwise noted, all work performed as prescribed by this item will be paid for as a unit rate (area or volume), in accordance with the contract. This work shall be measured by the square yard of completed and accepted cement stabilized base course. Measurement for cement shall be by the ton, 2000 pounds of dry weight, as determined by certified weight tickets for treatment of materials in place only. No allowance shall be made for any materials used or work done outside the

limits as established by the Owner. The work performed and material furnished as prescribed by this item and measured as provided in this item shall be paid for at the unit price bid for soil-cement treated base, or sub-base course, which price shall be full compensation for pulverizing the soil material; for handling; hauling and spreading cement; for mixing the cement with the pulverized soil; furnishing, hauling and mixing water with the soil-cement mixture; spreading and shaping the mixture; compacting the mixture, including all rolling required for this compaction; surface finishing; curing though prime coat shall be paid for in accordance with Section 2.5 Prime Coat; and for all manipulation, labor, equipment, appliances, tools and incidentals necessary to complete the work and carry out the maintenance provisions in this specification. Cement material for in place treatment measured as provided in this item shall be paid for at the unit price bid for cement material, which price shall be compensation for furnishing the material; for all freight involved, for all unloading and storing; and for all labor, equipment, fuels, tools and incidentals necessary to complete the work, all in accordance with the plans and these specifications.
