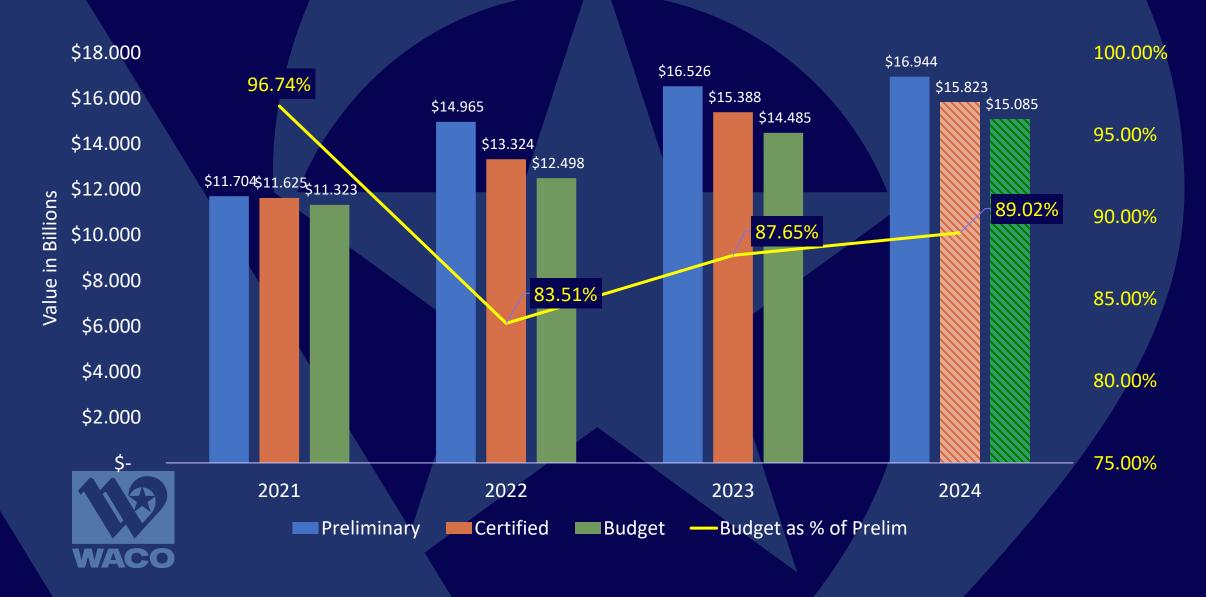

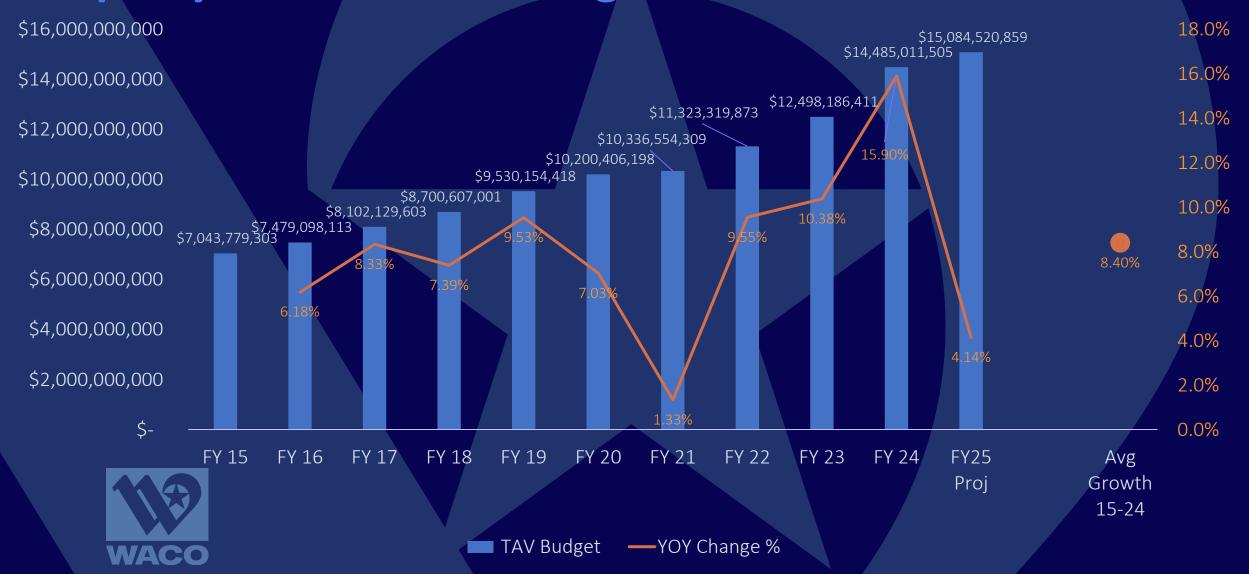




TAX ROLLS: TAXABLE VALUES 2021-2024



Property Taxes: Waco Budget TAV FY15-FY25*



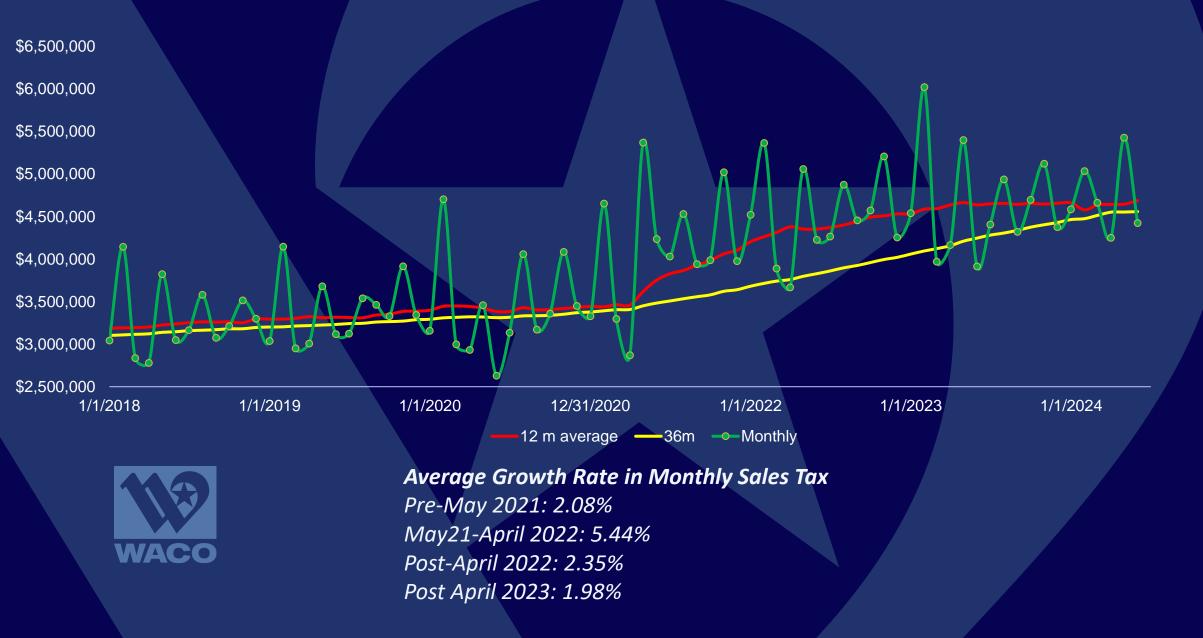

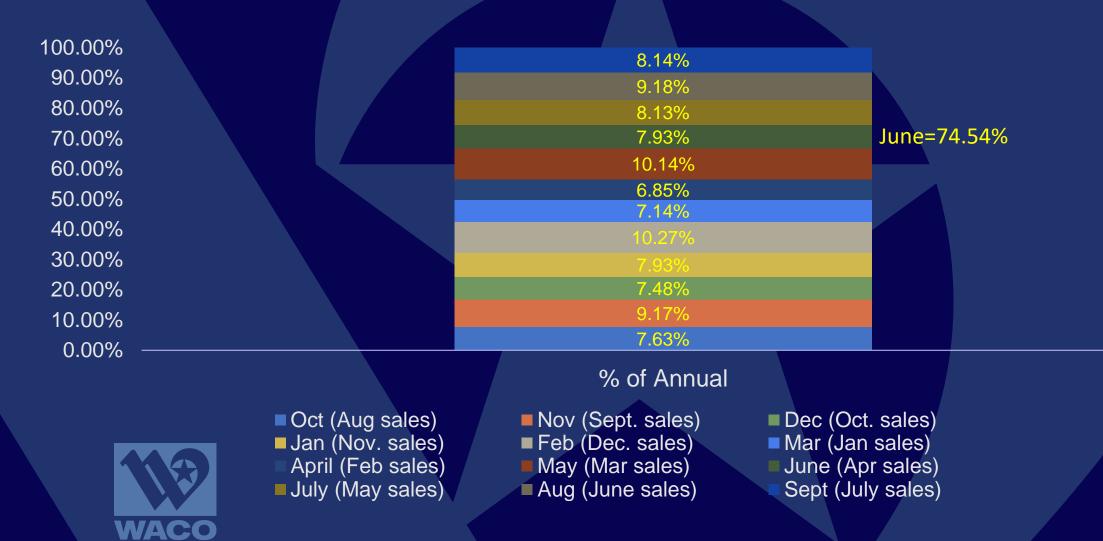


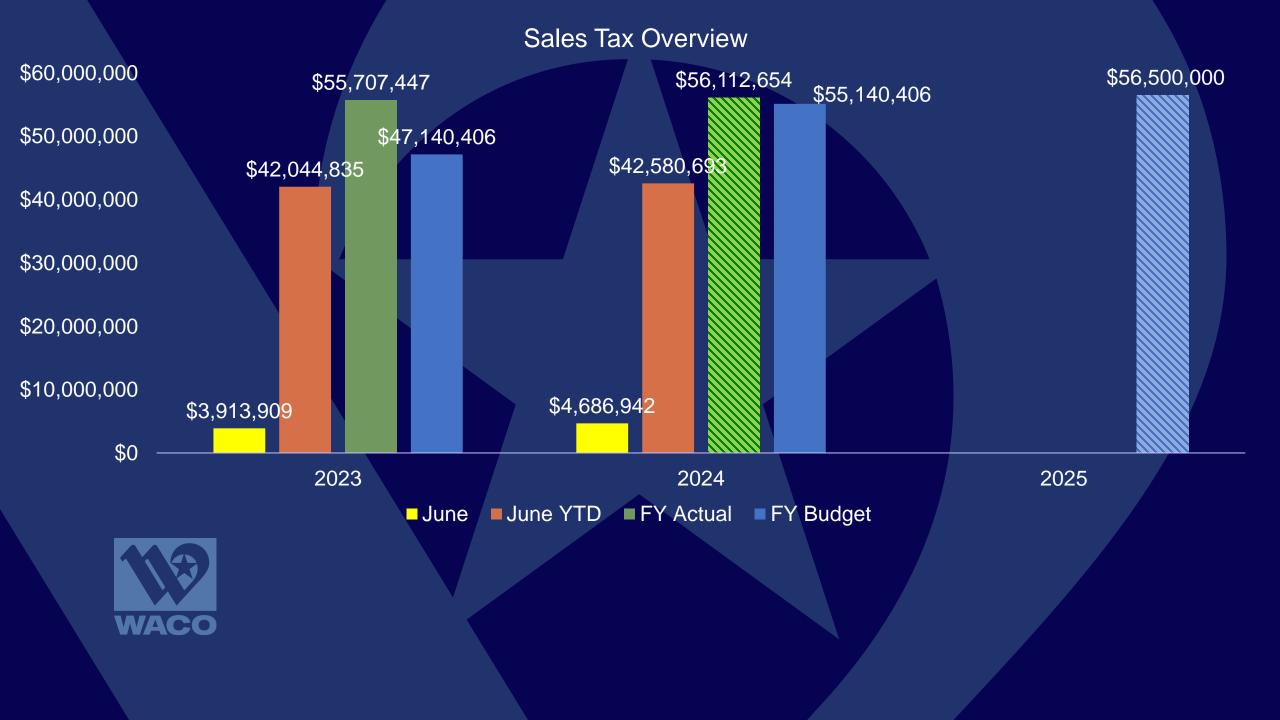


SALES TAX PAYMENTS AND TRENDS: 2018- PRESENT

 - Vacant positions
 - Discretionary accounts
 - Maintain Level Tax Rate
 - Evaluate Fee Schedule
- Set parameters for enterprise fund rates and fee increases
- Defer decision on New Programs and Service Enhancements until mid year 2025

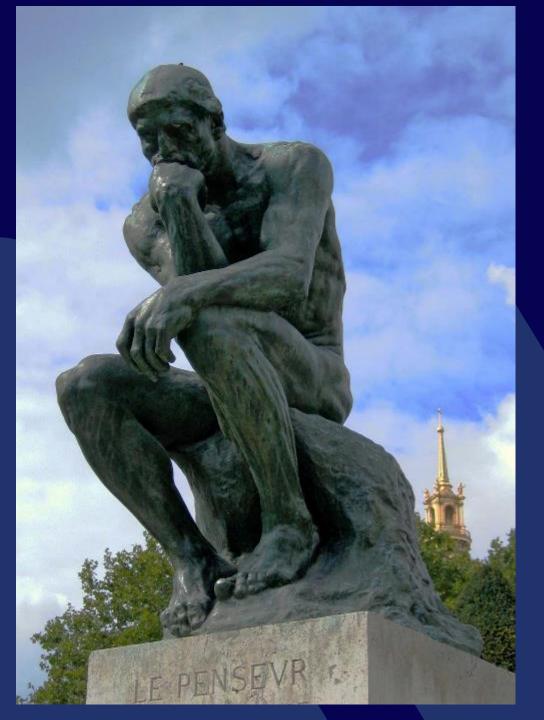
