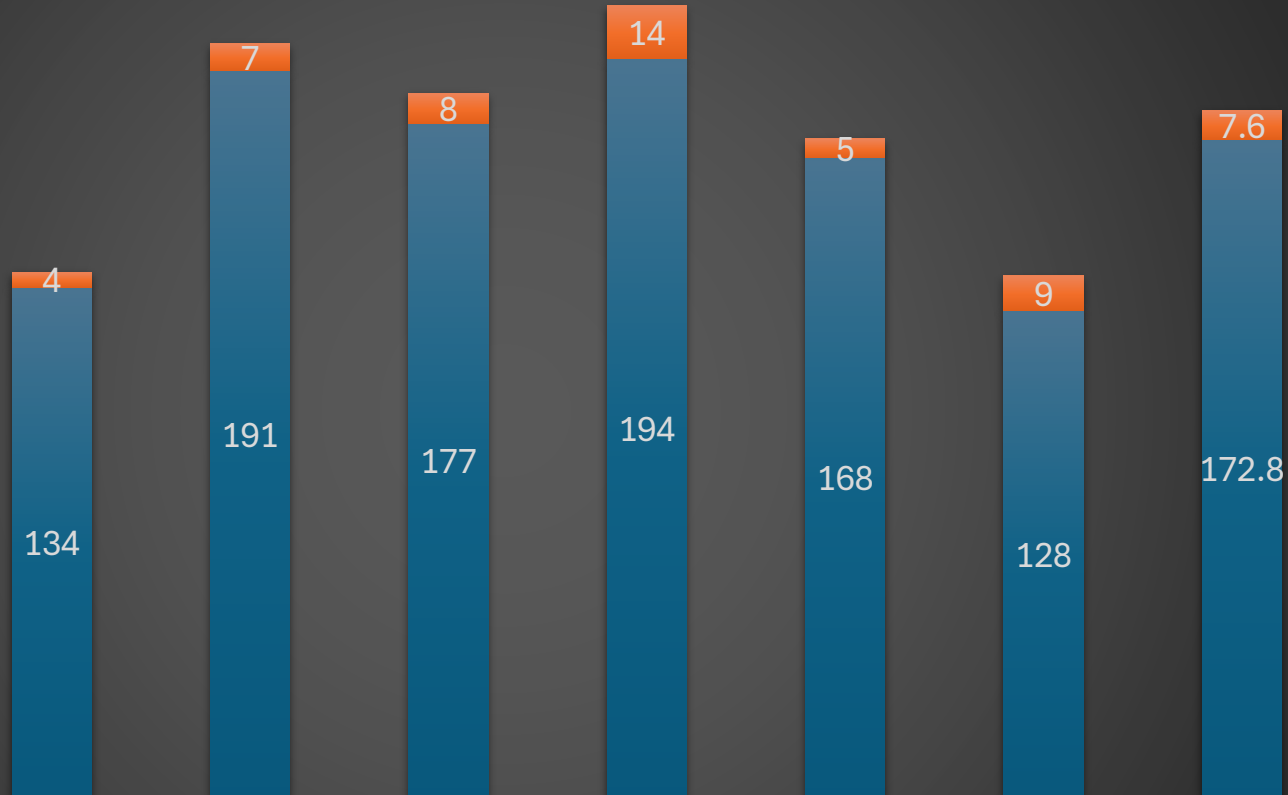

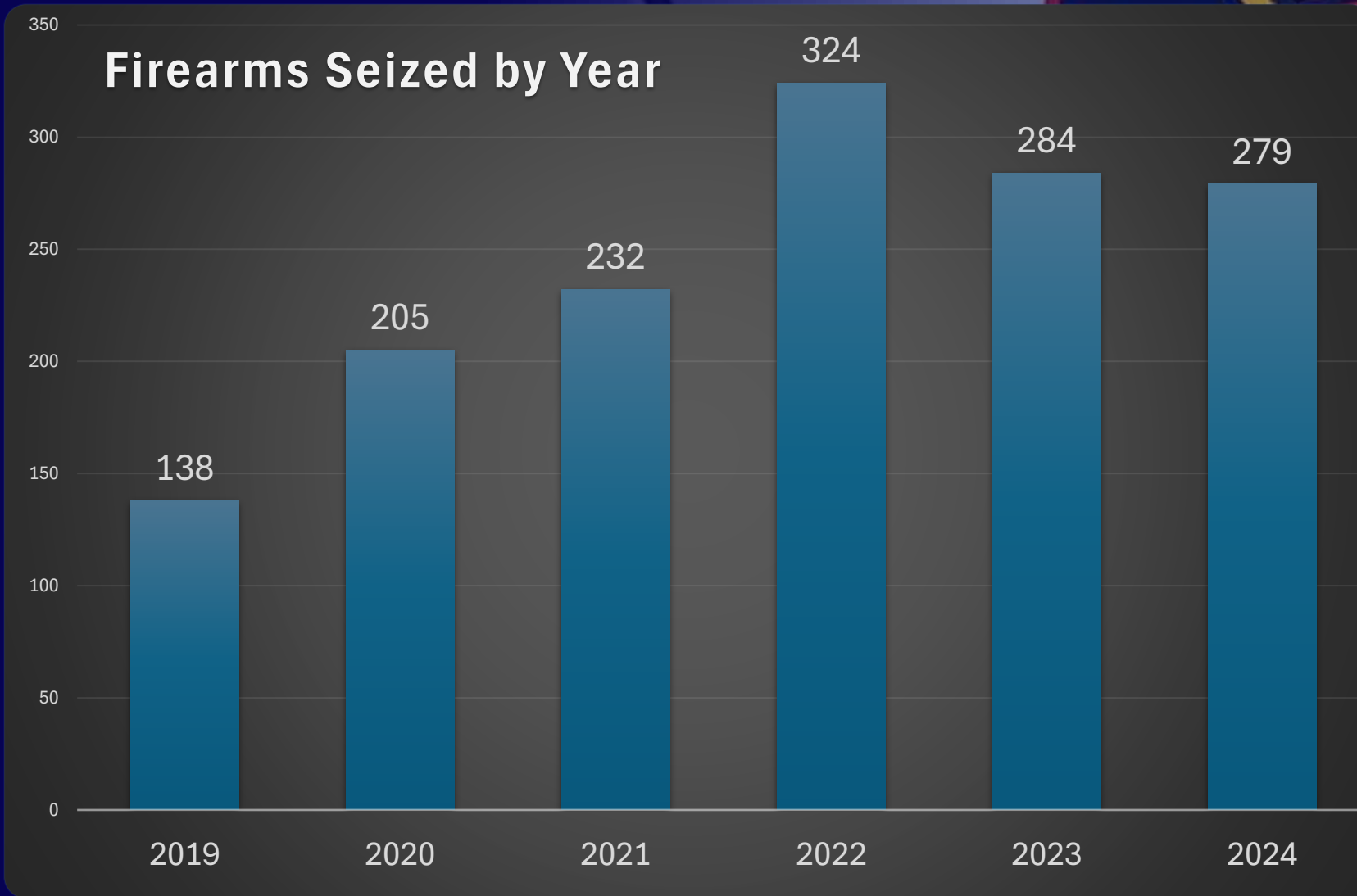

1. **Are asked on the scene; Victim participation is voluntary**  
Has physical violence **increased in frequency or severity** over the past six months? Alternate wording: Is the pushing, grabbing, hitting, or other violence happening more often

2. **Is he/she violently and constantly jealous of you?**  
Do you believe he/she is **capable of killing** you?

3. **Have he/she ever beaten you while you were pregnant?** (e.g. hit, kicked, shoved, pushed, thrown, or physically hurt with a weapon or object)

4. **Has he/she ever used a weapon or object to hurt or threaten you?**

5. **Has he/she ever tried to kill you?**

6. **Has he/she ever choked/strangled/suffocated you?**

7. **Has this happened more than once?**

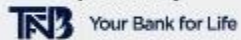
