CITY OF WACO SEEKS TO FILL VACANT DISTRICT V COUNCIL SEAT

WACO, TEXAS (May 15, 2024) — The City of Waco is seeking applications to fill the vacant District V City Council seat following the recent election of former District V Councilmember, Jim Holmes, to the position of mayor. The application filing period for interested candidates will be from Wednesday, May 15 through 5 p.m. on Friday, May 31.

Eligible applicants must be a United States citizen, be 21 years of age or older, and have resided in the State of Texas and the City of Waco for 12 months and in District V for at least six months.

The remaining members of City Council will interview the applicants on Thursday, June 6 at the Bosque Theater, Waco Convention Center, 100 Washington Ave. City Council will select the applicant by majority vote to fill the vacant District V seat for the unexpired term until the next City of Waco general election in May 2025. The selected applicant will be appointed and sworn in at a City Council meeting on Tuesday, June 25.
